THE TEAM of Vishwajeet and Mitesh Agarwal from Sun Microsystems emerged as winners in the Indore regional round of the Tata Crucible business quiz. The opening regional round of the Tata Crucible business quiz saw a sizeable turnout of teams from Indore based corporates. ed in a new avatar with 'nano quizzing' format introduced for the first time in corporate quiz. This pertains to a new round called 'nano words' that provides the team with a couple of clues to arrive at the final answer.

On winning the regional round at Indore the duo said, "Today, winning the regional round of the quiz is a proud moment for us. We now look forward to the national finals of Tata Crucible."

The quiz will now travel to Mumbai (September 20) and subsequently to Chennai (September 21). The grand finale will be held in the end of September.
